

# **KARNATAKA STATE WAKF FOUNDATION FOR WOMEN DEVELOPMENT**

The aim and object of the scheme is to promote the development of Muslim women and girls particularly in the field of

- a. Education
- b. Self-employment
- c. Improvement of working conditions in home/cottage industries like ready-made garments, handicrafts etc.
- d. Providing financial assistance to Muslim girl students appearing in competitive examinations etc.

Under the scheme, scholarships are being given every year to girl students from High School level to professional courses as a one-time grant in the following pattern:

1. High School students (Girls) from 2 <sup>th</sup> to 10 <sup>th</sup> standard	::	Rs. 500/- per student
2. M.B.B.S	::	Rs. 20,000/-per student
3. B.E./B.U.M.S/B.H.M.S/B.A.M.S	::	Rs. 10,000/-per student
4. B.D.S	::	Rs. 15,000/-per student
5. M.B.A	::	Rs. 10,000/-per student
6. D.Ed. (TCH) B.Ed.	::	Rs. 3,000/- per student
7. B.C.A	::	Rs. 5,000/- per student

## **Eligibility:**

The girl-students, whose parent/guardians income is less than Rs. 48,000/- per annum are eligible to apply for scholarship;

## **NEW SCHEMES BEING IMPLEMENTED BY KARNATAKA STATE WAKF FOUNDATION FOR WOMEN**

### **HEALTH RELIEF TO MUSLIM MINORITIES WOMEN & GIRLS**

In this scheme Medical relief is provided to Muslim Minorities women and girls for medical treatment on the following conditions.

1. The annual income of the beneficiary should be less than Rs. 1,20,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Twenty Thousand only). This scheme is not applicable to the Government servants.
2. Applications should be submitted in the prescribed proforma along with a copy of the Income Certificate issued by the Tahsildar and on estimate by the Hospital/Nursing Home approved by the Government.
3. Applications should be submitted by the husband or guardian of the patient only.
4. Patients suffering from dangerous diseases like Heart, Kidney, Brain, Cancer, T.B. (excluding scissoring 'c' section) and other diseases are also eligible to receive the grant.
5. Under this scheme relief of minimum of Rs. 5000/- and maximum of Rs. 25,000/- will be paid by cheque through the concerned hospital.
6. In certain exceptional cases relief will be paid by cheque to the patient within three months of settling of bills after taking treatment.

### **HOSTELS FOR WORKING MUSLIM MINORITY WOMEN**

This scheme provides marginal subsidy to working women in Govt, Quazi Govt., Public Sector Enterprises & Private Sector & Minorities Muslim Women residing in Hostels maintained by the NGOs on the following conditions.

1. Hostel facilities will be provided to those women who have submitted applications along with testimonial of their appointments and salaries.
2. In some special cases Muslim Women candidates studying in Post Metric classes may be permitted to stay in the hostel. This number shall not be more than 10.

3. The applicant should be more than 18 years old.
4. Applicant who's wish to stay in the hostels should not have child with them.
5. Muslim NGO's shall start and manage the hostels as per the conditions laid down by the K.S.W.F. for women development and accepted by tradition.
6. 4 hostels of this kind will be started in Bangalore and one each in every district.
7. NGOs selected to maintain this kind of hostels will be paid one time loan of Rs. 2.5 lakhs on concessional rates.
8. Concession of 50% of the rent payable to the NGO will be given by the K.S.W.F.W.D to the Muslim women whose salaries are less than Rs. 5,000/ - per month
9. The strength at the time of starting of the hostels should not be more than 50 candidates.
10. Salary grants for 1 Cook, 1 Assistant Cook/Aiya and 24 hours security establishment will be borne by the K.S.W.F.W.D.

### **STARTING PRE-PRIMARY SCHOOLS FOR MUSLIM CHILDREN BY THE NGOs**

Under this scheme NGOs can start Pre-primary schools for Muslim children on the following conditions.

1. As the number of persons speaking urdu language is more, assistance will be provided for NGOs who starts Pre-primary schools wherever they are needed.
2. Assistance will be provided to NGOs who starts Pre-primary schools near Government Urdu Primary schools.
3. If the Pre-primary school is to be started other than the place where Urdu primary is located the school should be managed through the NGO.
4. The teacher working in these schools should have passed NTT or Nursery

courses. Subsidy of Rs. 3,000/- to the teacher and Rs. 2000/- to the helper will be paid through the organisation.

5. The organisations should not collect fees from the candidate.
6. This responsibility will be handed over to sincere hard working and responsible self help group.
7. The age of the children should be between 3-5 years at the time of admission.

### **HOSTELS FOR MUSLIM WOMEN DESTITUTES**

Hostel facilities will be provided to Muslim Women destitutes on the following conditions.

1. Registered NGOs/Trusts and other organisation having experience are eligible to get benefits from this scheme.
2. The minimum age to get admission in the Hostel for destitute Muslim woman shall be 18 years.
3. Destitute woman can stay in this hostel for a maximum period of 6 months.
4. These women may trained in different professions and provided an opportunity to take up self employment.
5. Hostel building should have place for accommodation of 50 women, Rest room, Class room, Kitchen etc.
6. There should be a warden, cooking staff (1 cook, 1 assistant, 1 helper) for the management of the hostel.
7. Monthly subsidy of Rs. 5,000/- to warden, Rs. 3,000/- to cook, Rs. 2,000/- to watchman will be paid by K.S.W.F.W.D.
8. Expenditure towards the Food and Rent of the building will be borne by K.S.W.F.W.D.
9. During the year applications are invited from the N to start 4 hostels in Bangalore, 1 in Davanagere, 1 in Shimoga, 1 in Mangalore, 1 in Gulbarga and 1 in Mysore.

## **PROVIDING COMPUTER TRAINING TO MINORITIES MUSLIM WOMEN**

This scheme extends financial assistance to Educational Institutions and NGOs and other Institutions providing free computer training and have their own infrastructure by sanctioning grants to and for salaries of the Trainers/ Teachers subject to the following conditions.

1. Educational Institutions, those providing computer training, NGOs/ Institutions having infrastructure providing free computer training to Muslim Girls for 6 months shall submit applications.
2. The period for training shall be 6 months and training to 2 batches i.e., morning and evening shall be provided to at least 50 candidates.
3. Teachers imparting training should be qualified and experienced in providing computer training.
4. A Honorarium of Rs. 5,000/- (Five thousand only) to the teacher and Rs.3,000/- (Three Thousand only) to the Assistant Teacher providing computer training will be paid by the Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development.

## **STIPEND TO MUSLIM MINORITY GIRLS LEARNING DTP COURSE**

Under this scheme stipend will be given to Muslim Minority Girls learning Urdu DTP course through NGO's on the following conditions.

1. Minority Muslim Girls learning urdu DTP course in organisations are eligible to apply.
2. A stipend of Rs. 2,000/- will be paid to minority muslim girls who are learning this course.
3. The period of the course shall be atleast 6 months.
4. Applications should be submitted to the foundation by getting them attested by the concerned organisations.
5. Cheques will be sent to the concerned candidates through NGOs.

## **Training of Muslim Women in stitching, embroidery and knitting - reg.**

In this scheme of training in stitching, embroidery and knitting for the Muslim women in the State to be implemented through the NGOs on the following conditions-

1. The training period would be for the duration of 6 months with 2 batches of 25-30 students per day.
2. The NGO's can adjust the timings of the training to suit the convenience of trainees with a fixed component such as both in the morning and afternoon.
3. The training shall be imparted by well qualified committed trainers with vast experience in cutting and stitching.
4. The Honorarium of Rs. 3,500/- per month in respect of the trainer and Rs. 2,000/- per month in respect of the Asst. Trainer will be borne by the Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development.
5. An amount of Rs. 100/- per month would be provided to each of the trainee for training material. This amount will not be given in cash but material will be supplied in the training classes. This expenditure would be met by the Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development.
6. At the end of the training period successful candidates will be provided with Sewing Machine subject to the condition that 50% of the cost shall be met by the trainees or the NGOs. And for orphan and widows Sewing machines will be provided free of cost by the Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development.
7. The NGOs should have their own infrastructure facilities. Preference will be given to those who have their own building or accommodation. Actual electricity and other maintenance charges will be borne by the Foundation.
