Sub: Activities of Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development- modification of scheme-reg.

Read: G.O.No. RD 39 WGA 91, dated 27-3-1992.

PREAMBLE:

In Government Order read above, the Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development came into existence with a budgetary provision of Rs. 25.00 lakhs in the budget 1991-92. The scheme was introduced because of the fact that even though the Government of Karnataka had formulated and implemented various schemes for the furtherance of the social, economic and overall development of the Women in the State, these schemes did not appear effective in enhancing the confidence and capability of the muslim women of Karnataka.

Even though the Foundation, gives a wide range of developmental schemes for the muslim women in Karnataka, the Foundation was hijacked by mere sanction of loans to the individuals and sanction of loan-cum-scholarships to the students of pre matric and professional courses.

Ever since the scheme of sanctioning individual loans was started, no recoveries have been made nor the beneficiaries repaid the loan borrowed. Besides, there are number of complaints that the loans so sanctioned are not reaching the deserving and the middle men are playing havoc with the illiterate muslim women who are seeking the loans under the scheme by misusing the funds so sanctioned. The entire exercise of sanctioning and recovery of loan to the individuals has become futile.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO.MWD 607 WFW 2008, BANGALORE DATED THE 24TH MAY, 2008.

For the reasons assigned in the preamble Government is pleased to order that henceforth no loans to the individual beneficiary will be sanctioned and the scheme of Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development shall be implemented extending financial assistance to the muslim women through the institutions, organizations, NGOs and Trusts etc. who are committed and working for the development of the muslim women in the State.

Financial assistance shall be extended only to the following schemes:-

1. To organize workshops in order to inculcate a sense of self-confidence, self reliance, self-sufficiency and fearlessness among the women so as to make them suitable for positions of responsibility by NGOs, Trusts, Societies, Associations etc.
2. To organize seminars, lecture, conferences to discuss social, economic, legal and other vital problems concerning the women;
3. To improve working conditions when women are employed in home/cottage/Industries other than beedi and agarbathis;
4. To provide financial and other aid to NGOs, Trusts, Societies, Associations, institutions/organizations engaged in the promotion of development of the women;
5. To affiliate to itself or to collaborate with NGOs, Trusts, Societies, Associations societies/organizations seeking the same objective or objectives similar to those of the Foundation so that the programme/activities leading to the achievement of these objectives may be more effectively co-coordinated;
6. To provide special assistance and opportunity to the women for technical and vocational education coaching of candidates for competitive examinations and entrance to professional colleges, remedial and promotional classes at the middle and higher secondary school level and provisions of hostels for the girls;
7. To help organize social services by establishing or assisting in establishment of Care Home for the women in distress and also train them in job oriented trades so that they may stand on their own legs and live as useful citizens;
8. To establish or assist in establishment of crèches, nursery schools and family counseling and legal aid centers in thickly populated Minorities areas with a view of encouraging more women of minorities to seek even small jobs and improve their economic conditions.
9. Sanction of computers to the educational institutions managed by NGOs, Trusts, Societies, Associations etc, belonging to muslims to impart computer education to muslim women (50% loan 50% subsidy).
10. Sanction of sewing machines to the muslim institutions, NGOs, Trusts, Societies, Associations etc, working-for the upliftment of muslim women. In this case the institutions/ NGOs, Trusts, Societies, Associations etc, would be asked to train the muslim women in dress making for a period of six months and after their training sewing machines will be allotted to the trained muslim women. 50% of the cost of the sewing machine shall be borne by the beneficiary.

Government also accord approval for sanction of full scholarship to the muslim girl students instead of the present loan-cum-scholarship.
