Shri. Mohammed Sanaulla, IAS, Principal Secretary Minorities Welfare Department, welcomed the Chief Secretary, Principal Secretary Home Department, DG& IGP, Non-official members and all other officers present at the meeting.

Subjects were taken up for review as per Agenda.

**Agenda No.1 : Confirmation of the proceedings of the 2nd Meeting held on
30.08.2010 and Review of Action Taken Report**

The Non-official Members present informed the Chief Secretary that the District Level meetings are not being conducted in many Districts regularly, especially in the districts of Belgaum, Chitradurga, Davanagere, Gulburga, Hassan etc. The Chairman and Chief Secretary assured the members that the Deputy Commissioners will be directed to conduct District level meetings regularly.

The Chief Secretary, reviewed the Action taken report on the proceedings of the previous meeting, which were read and recorded with the following observations/suggestions/instructions.

1. **Home Department** : Principal Secretary, Home Department informed that the compensation to the families of persons who lost their life in communal riots is increased from Rs.1 lakh to Rs.2 lakhs by State Government, as the Union Government has fixed Rs. 3 lakhs compensation for the loss of life in communal riots. The Chief Secretary requested Principal Secretary Home Department and the Director General of Police to settle the pending cases of payment of compensation by initiating special drive. Action taken in this regard may be informed during the next meeting.
2. **Education Department**: It was suggested by members that many Urdu Primary/Higher Primary Schools are being closed due to low enrolment of children. Chief Secretary instructed the Education Department to avoid closure of Urdu Primary/Higher Primary Schools and advised them to take up drive for enrolment of school going children in such Schools.
About Non-utilisation of funds under Sarva Shikshana Abhiyana scheme, the Chief Secretary instructed the Education Department to fix up a target for each District and to allocate funds and the same should be fully utilized for Government Schools meant for minorities.
3. **Director for Minorities Welfare** : While taking note of the ATR regarding release of Scholarships, it was informed by members that there is delay in release of scholarships sanctioned to minority students. The Chairman suggested to Principal Secretary, Minority Welfare Department that from the next financial year 2011-12 amount may be disbursed on 'on line system' through e-governance and requested him to adopt the software being used by Social Welfare Department for disbursement of scholarships to SC/ST and backward Classes.
4. **Planning Department**: It was informed by Senior Director (Planning) that the targets for minorities should be fixed by the concerned Department and planning department has no role to play. The Chief Secretary advised that targets for minorities should be forthwith fixed by important departments like Education, Women and Child Welfare,
